The implementation of the North London Joint Waste Strategy will proceed in a variety of ways, including through the on-going management of contracted services, the North London Waste Prevention Plan 2018-20. Third party reuse and recycling credits will be reviewed in 2019/2020 to ensure the scheme is beneficial to the Authority and charities alike. Bids for financial support from external bodies will also come forward.

#### 4. CORPORATE MANAGEMENT

4.1. At the organisational level, the Authority continues to have regard to potential risks, to oversee its shareholder interest in LondonEnergy Ltd, and to manage its relationships with the constituent borough councils.

5.1. Budget approval reports and Accounts sign off by the Audit Committee are included, together with the regular budget reviews.

#### 6. NORTH LONDON HEAT AND POWER PROJECT (NLHPP)

- 6.1. This section covers reports to take forward specific aspects of the Authority's approach to the treatment of residual waste, which will be updated to take account of Members' decisions on the timeline for future activity.
- 6.2. With the establishment of a Programme Committee for the NLHPP a separate Forward Programme is provided for the NLHPP, taken from the Forward Programme presented on 3 June to the NLHPP Programme Committee. The NLHPP Forward Programme includes the timing of decisions on procurement relating to future residual waste facilities. Going forward, as well as an indication of the timing of decisions, this report will include timings of presentation of policies and strategies for agreement or review.
