The paper on auditor appointment which is on the agenda for the current meeting is in response to an action from the last meeting. Otherwise the forward look reflects that set out on 10 February.
- 1.3. The Forward Plan has been divided into sections as set out below. In addition to papers for consideration at meetings, officers have, as necessary, provided updates to Members on the management of services during Coronavirus restrictions. The timing of issues going forward has some uncertainties some issues may need expediting while others may be deferred (particularly where dependent on external organisations who might have different priorities).
