Family days FAQs



Where is the family day?

The event is being held at EcoPark House, 1 Lee Park Way, Edmonton EcoPark, London, N18 3BJ.

What time does the event begin?

The event begins at 10:30am but you can drop-in anytime until 1pm.
The event finishes at 13:30pm.

Please do not turn up to the event before 10:30pm. You will not be admitted to the event early.

Do I need to print my tickets?

You do not need to print your tickets, but you will be asked to show your digital ticket upon arrival.

Entry to the event is by ticket only. Unfortunately, we won't be able to admit anyone without a valid ticket.

Is there parking at the event?

This event is strictly car-free and there is no parking available.
We kindly ask all guests to arrive on foot or via public transport. Please be aware that those arriving by car will not be admitted. There is very limited bike storage available.

The event says 7 years and up, can I bring younger children?

We have suggested that this event is for 7 years + as a lot of the activities, including the tour, have an age restriction.

You may bring younger children however they may not be able to participate in all the activities.

What activities are part of the event?

We have a range of fantastic activities brought to you by our local community groups. These include:

- **Play it again!** are offering a toy repair stall (7 and 28 August)
- **London Cycling Club** are running a workshop on how to fix a bike (7 and 28 August)
- **Woodshop of Recycled Delights** are creating bird/bat boxes (7 August only)
- **Papertunity** are running a recycled paper craft workshop (28 August only)
- Food waste workshops (7 and 28 August)

NLWA are also running activities which include creating tin can bug hotels and a tour of the Resource Recovery Facility!

What toys can I bring to be repaired?

You can bring a variety of toys along to be repaired but no electronic toys please!

Can I bring my bike to be fixed?

No, unfortunately we are not offering bike repairs at this event.

London Cycling Club will be providing bikes for you to practise fixing so that you can take the skills home and fix your own.

How can I sign up for activities?

All activities will operate on a first come, first served basis on the day.

Will I be able to purchase food at the event?

There will be light refreshments provided for free at the event. There is no cafe or shop on site to buy food.

Can I bring my own food to the event?

Yes, you are welcome to bring your own lunch to the event. However, we ask that any food you bring is **nut-free** and that you dispose of your food waste in the appropriate bin.



Travelling to EcoPark House

This event is strictly car-free and there is no parking available.

Bus

We recommend taking either the No. 34 bus (Barnet to Walthamstow Bus Station) or the No. 444 bus (Turnpike Lane Bus Station to Chingford Station). Both buses stop at the Harbet Road, Cooks Ferry stop. Bus stops are outlined on the map below for easy reference.

Please note, it may require crossing the A406 to reach EcoPark House.



Train

The nearest station is Greater Anglia's Meridian Water, about an 18-minute walk away, with services from Stratford and Bishops Stortford. Other nearby stations include Edmonton Green and Silver Street, both served by the TfL London Overground, with connections from London Liverpool Street, Enfield Town, and Cheshunt.
