Reuse and Recycling Credits: 2024-25 Update

This document is intended for members of the Reuse and Recycling credits scheme, and serves as an update to the <u>information about the scheme on our website</u>.

1: Applying for the scheme

Scheme members have <u>until 1 May to apply for the 2024-5 scheme</u>, which runs April to April as always. Please excuse our delay in opening the scheme this year.

The application form is no longer paper based. <u>You can access our new digital version here</u>, and should only need to complete it in full once per financial year. The declaration is binding and replaces the pen and paper signature.

Apply for the 2024-25 round

If your application is successful, we will send you a purchase order number for your annual claim based on your annual tonnage estimate, and we will add you to our finance system as a supplier. The amount attached to this PO number is for administrative purposes only and is not a commitment to a maximum or minimum spend.

2: Submitting evidence

We no longer require members to post a full list of paper receipts to us every quarter and retain them indefinitely. Instead:

- The quarterly tonnage spreadsheet should be completed and submitted to us every quarter, as before. Please use the version we send to you when we confirm your application.
- We no longer need you to post physical receipts to us on a quarterly basis. However, when
 required (e.g. for auditing purposes), you will have to provide relevant evidence of your
 submission. This can be any of the following:
 - Individual paper receipts
 - Scans / photos of the individual paper receipts
 - o The report of collection from your licensed waste carrier
- We will need you to keep digital or physical receipts for 5 years, for audit purposes.
- You can submit your invoice at the same time as your quarterly data submission. The format will be confirmed at a later date.

3: Who can help
