## Darn IT! HOW TO REPAIR A HOLE





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Once you have sewn rows of thread all the way across the hole, continue to create a few more, until you have reached 1cm to the left of the hole. This will ensure a strong mend.

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6. Congratulations - you have created a 'warp' (a set of vertical threads)! To complete the darn, you will now need to weave the weft (horizontal threads). Stitch a few times on one spot and cut off the end of this thread. Now thread the needle off the end of this thread.

again.
7. From the top left-hand corner, begin making small stitches horizontally across the darning

area.
8. When you come to the end, reverse your direction, as before. However, this time, when you reach the hole in the middle, direct the needle over, then under each of the warp threads.

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10. Continue sewing your horizontal rows until you reach the bottom of the darning area. Close up the thread underneath (as before) to finish.

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
