WHAT HAPPENS TO YOUR RECYCLING?

WE TAKE IT

We collect it from your house and take it to the recycling sorting centre.

WE SORT IT

It is sorted into different types and sold to companies that want to use it.

WHERE IT ENDS UP

All metal, plastic, glass, and most paper, stays in the UK.

IT BECOMES SOMETHING NEW

CANS are recycled, filled and back on the shelf in six weeks.

TINS can be used to make train tracks, cars or even paperclips.

PLASTIC could be turned into packaging again, or even car bumpers, drainage pipes or flower pots.

GLASS gets turned into glass bottles and jars again.
