Alternatively, one can also apply together with a more established charity.	None
2	29 June 2020	A project that reduces household e-waste involves individuals or corporates donating unused electronics which are then refurbished and passed on to community groups. Is the project still eligible to apply if part of the waste prevention element involves reducing commercial waste?	None	01 July 2020	Projects that set out to only reduce commercial waste (i.e. waste collected from businesses that would not be collected by a local authority) are not eligible. However, if a project includes local authority collected waste as well as commercial waste, please give an estimate of the proportion of commercial waste in your project description. 3	22 June 2020	This is a food growing project involving the use of waste containers for growing. We would like to use compost produced from north London's waste as the growing medium. Is the project eligible for funding and could we pay for getting some north London compost back from outside London where it is processed to use for the project?	None	01 July 2020	The project is eligible for support as it is proposed to use waste containers (which would normally go into local authority collected waste) for another use. Transporting north London compost back to north London may be difficult and would require the	None

4		Is a project eligible if it sets out to reduce school waste?	None	01 July 2020	Schools waste is not always collected by the local authority. The Fund is available for projects whose main objective involves reducing local authority collected waste. Therefore, if a schools project is successful in receiving a provisional offer of support we would require evidence prior to funding that the school(s) involved had a waste collection service from the local authority. If not, then the project would not be eligible for support.	None
5	24 June 2020	Part of the project proposal involves cooking meals using surplus food donated by food distributors and local food retailers. Part of this means reducing commercial waste. Is the project still eligible to apply?	None	01 July 2020	If a project includes local authority collected waste as well as commercial waste, please give an estimate of the proportion of commercial waste in your project description.
